APPETIZERS

In Summer quarter (July, August, September) we served a combined total of 881 households of that 953 were children, 1385 were adults, 269 were seniors for a total of 2610 people. We distributed 41450 pounds of food to those in need in the Lake Region and we received 8040 pounds of food donated through the community.

MAIN COURSE

Summer kept us pretty busy with clients, gardening, and mobile pantry distribution. We took in 6443 pounds of fresh garden produce thanks to local farmers and gardeners. On July 10th we had a mobile pantry at Bethel Church Parking Lot that served 100 households, of that 108 were children, 109 were adults, and 52 were seniors. We gave out fresh produce and mobile pantry boxes
